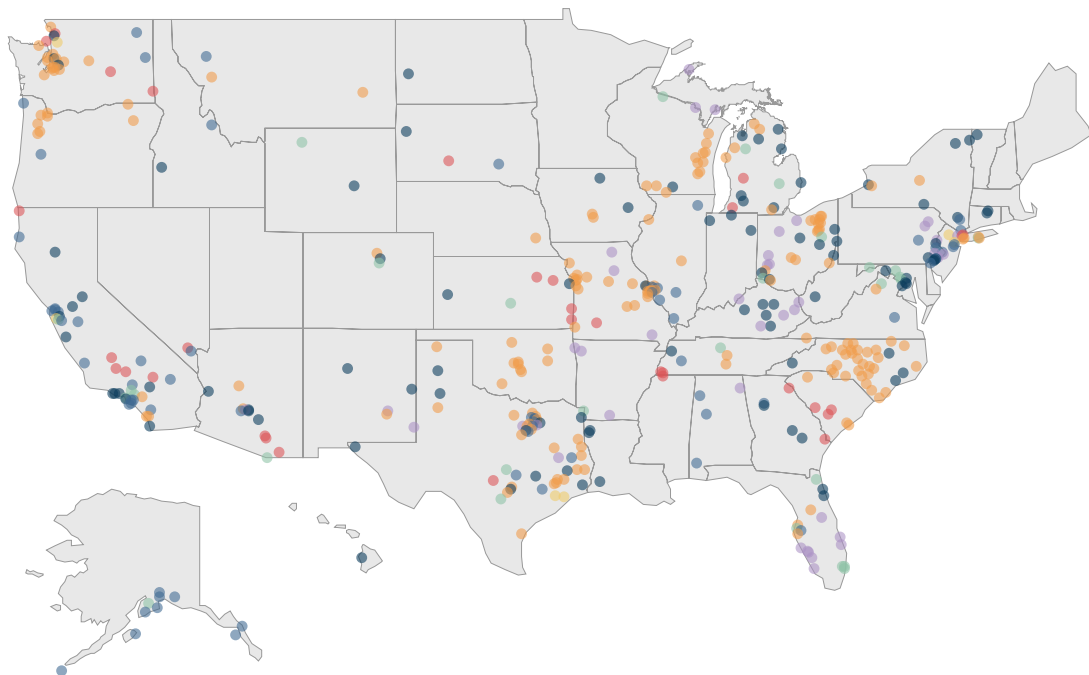
ABOUT THE ROLE

The Medical Director of Advisory Services is a high-visibility leader within the medical staff. In this role, you are directly responsible for utilization management activities for the hospital partner, serving as a liaison to providers, case management, revenue cycle, and compliance professionals onsite to improve the accuracy of clinical documentation improvement efforts. Additionally, the Medical Director of Advisory Services typically leads, if not chairs, the utilization management committee for the hospital.
